



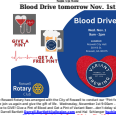



Bring a smile to a child's face this holiday season by donating toys and gift cards.

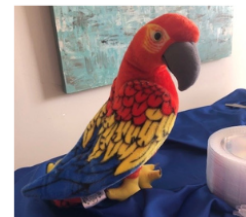
